

Activities in Adjusting Courses

1. Compare course learning outcomes to program outcomes (ref. Ministry guidelines)
2. Review course learning outcomes covered to date before strike started.
3. Review course learning outcomes remaining.
4. Compare course learning outcomes to courses subsequent in program (to find out where else course learning outcomes may be replicated).
5. Decide how to cover remaining course learning outcomes.
6. Arrange and meet with other faculty teaching the same course to compare course adjustments.
7. Create, adjust, combine class tasks, exercises, simulations, content.
8. Create, adjust evaluation methods and tools for revised course.
 - a. Because of the change in the fall term, you may have to create or adjust planned evaluations.
 - b. The college is allowing students with prior travel plans to be absent from classes during the week of Dec. 18-22. These students have been told they will be accommodated upon their return in the new year. This means you may have to create different evaluations, (such as a test) for each student, if they are not able to complete the evaluation at the same time. You should estimate how much additional time this will take.
9. Make adjustments to course written material and web based learning tools.
